





What to expect this spring?

County H

- Late March/early April start
- Traffic to remain in current configuration
- Three weekend closures for storm sewer crossings
- Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in work zone
- Two closures of Braun Road to the east to reconstruct the intersection

County KR (from Frontage Road to County H)

- Early April start
- Traffic to remain in current configuration
- Construct westbound lanes first
- Speed limit reduced to 45 mnh in work zone



What to expect this spring?

International Drive

- Storm sewer work
- 45 day closure of Louis Sorenson to construct new intersection

Braun Road

- Mid-April start
- Reconstruct eastbound lanes through early summer

Wisconn Valley Way

- Let March 12
- Work scheduled to begin in April




I-94 North-South Update

North segment

- Reconstruction of SB lanes through late 2019
- Lane closure northbound I-94 from County G to Ryan Road due to weather/pavement conditions

Central/South segments

- Reconstruction of median through spring 2019
- Reconstruction of SB lanes and entrance/exit ramps summer through late 2019


